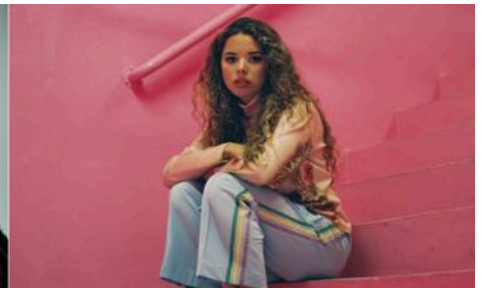

»Pop-Kultur« reveals the second part of the 2018 live programme and launches the application phase for the workshop programme »Pop-Kultur Nachwuchs«:

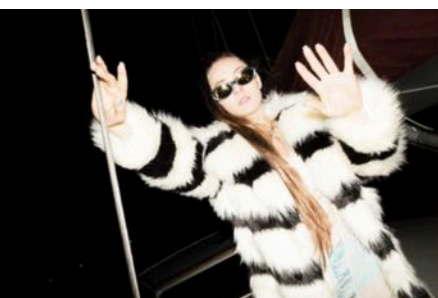
In addition to Haiyti, Pan Daijing, John Maus, Kat Frankie, Henrik Schwarz & Alma Quartet and more, the 2018 »Pop-Kultur« line-up now also includes Neneh Cherry, Die Nerven, Nilüfer Yanya, Ace Tee & Kwam.e, and many others. The festival will take place this year from August 15th-17th, once again on the grounds of Berlin's Kulturbrauerei.

The **Live Programme** will also be expanded with further »Pop-Kultur Commissioned Works«, which are made possible with the support of the Federal Government Commissioner for Culture and the Media (BKM). **Automat, Karen Gwyer, Staatsakt** and others will develop new works for the three-day festival. A special highlight: for the **15th birthday** of the label **Staatsakt**, the band **Die Türen** are bringing an entirely new show onto the »Pop-Kultur« stage: »**Exoterik**«! To produce it, they'll be

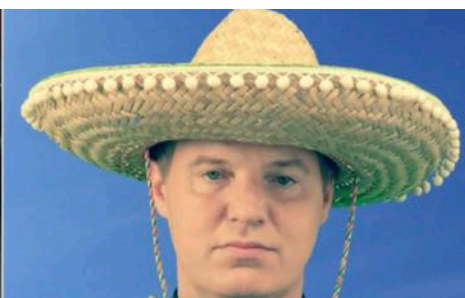
living for an indefinite period of time in a rural commune and coming back at the latest in August with an hour of new music built on the pillars of krautrock, post-punk, and psychedelic.



Die Nerven by Christian Bendel



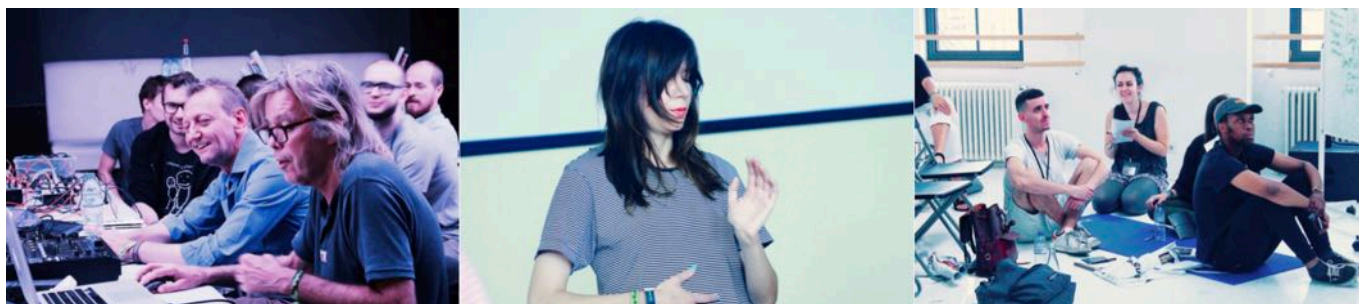
